We are excited to gather as a school community for our Parent–Teacher Conferences on November 6, 2025 for all students in Grade Pre-K through 8. As we conclude Trimester One, this important checkpoint allows teachers to share the most complete picture of your child's progress, including finalized assessments and meaningful samples of work, while also providing a short window for students to make adjustments before final trimester one grades are due. SS. Cyril and Methodius Halloween Costume Guidelines

Friday, October 31, 2025, will be designated a special out-of-uniform day with students free to dress in celebration of Halloween. Guidelines for attire are as follows:

- 1. Students may choose to dress in regular school attire.
- 2. Students may choose to dress in Friday Spirit Wear attire.
- 3. Students may choose to dress in Halloween color attire (black and orange).
- 4. Students may choose to dress in costume attire. If a student decides to dress in costume, the following guidelines are in place:
 - a. Costumes must uphold our pride and Catholic school identity.
 - b. Costumes must reflect each student's good nature and creativity.
 - c. Costumes must allow for an uninterrupted educational experience throughout the day.
 - d. Costumes must be appropriate in length and appearance.
 - e. Students must wear appropriate footwear.
 - f. Costumes must not conceal a student's identity.
 - g. Costumes must not be offensive, inappropriate, make fun of others, or make others uncomfortable.
 - h. No inflatable costumes are permitted.
 - i. No weapons of any kind are permitted.

While we trust the decisions of our student body, the SSCM Principal will have the final say as to the appropriateness of a costume and reserves the right to send a student home to change.

SSCM students can participate in our annual trunk or treat throughout the school and in the gym at 9:00 am. Parents are welcome to attend our trunk or treat.

Finally, we will be on an 11:00 am dismissal schedule.
