Dear SSCM Parents,

We are extremely honored to serve your family at SS. Cyril and Methodius School, and do not take for granted the confidence and trust you place in us to educate your child(ren) in our faith-based community. The 2025/2026 school year has been an incredible year of growth. We have seen a 6% increase in enrollment and are on pace to exceed our norms in both academic achievement and spiritual engagement. While this year has been a great success, we look forward to an even stronger 2026/2027 school year with the addition of the following programs to help better animate our mission:

1. **STEM** - All Pre-K through Grade 8 students will take a STEM course dedicated to helping students identify and solve real world problems relevant to their lives.
2. **LEADERSHIP** - Seventh and eighth grade students will take a course geared toward 21st century leadership development.
3. **SEL** - Students will experience intentional SEL (Social Emotional Learning) exercises to help all students reach age-appropriate milestones and foster personal growth.

In our recent satisfaction survey, "Student Well Being" was rated as the most important school attribute with 90% of respondents sharing it is extremely important. As SSCM continues to evolve and grow, I believe the above programs will enhance the experience of all students by promoting the well-being of each child.

I am excited to share that in an effort to make registration for the 2026/2027 school year as easy and seamless for families as possible, we will adopt an automatic re-enrollment process by instilling the following procedures:

- If your child(ren) are returning and you do not have a new sibling to register, no action is needed. Your FACTS account will simply be billed \$160 per child for 2026/2027 registration on February 4.
- If you have siblings to register, please contact Mrs. Lazowski in the main office to complete registration by February 3 to reserve a spot in each class.
- If you do not plan to return to SSCM, please complete the following form - [2026/2027 Exit Form](#) - and Mr. Turney will contact you to better understand your situation.

The school, school board, and parish are in the process of finalizing next year's tuition and will communicate that as soon as possible. Families should prepare for a standard 4-5% tuition increase to cover the salary increase set for all schools by the Archdiocese of Chicago Office of Catholic Schools. Please note that the Archdiocese of Chicago and SSCM has a number of programs to help with tuition if re-enrollment becomes financially unsustainable.

As we look ahead to the 2026/2027 school year, our greatest hope is to continue this journey together with each and every one of our current families. Our goal is simple and sincere: to re-enroll 100% of our students, ensuring that each child can continue to grow academically, spiritually, and personally within the SSCM community they call home. Your partnership, trust, and presence are what make our school thrive, and we are deeply grateful for the opportunity to educate your children each day. We are excited for what lies ahead and look forward to welcoming all of our families back for another exceptional year at SS. Cyril and Methodius School.

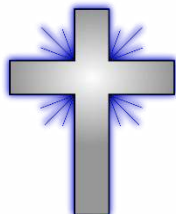

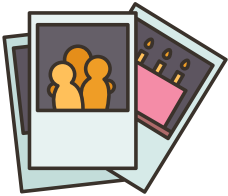
