Updated Arrival Procedures at SSCM

Dear SSCM Families,

As we begin a new school year, one of our priorities is creating a morning arrival experience that is safe, welcoming, organized, and focused on helping every student begin the day ready to learn. Beginning on Monday, August 17, we will implement an important change to our morning arrival procedures.

Families are encouraged to drop students off at the front entrance, where SSCM faculty and staff will be ready to welcome them into the building. Parents who would prefer to walk their child inside are welcome to accompany their child into the school foyer. However, beginning Monday, parents will not accompany students beyond the foyer into the school hallways or classrooms.

We recognize that this will be a change for some of our families, particularly those with our youngest students. Please know that your children will have plenty of support along the way. A number of SSCM faculty and support staff will be stationed throughout the foyer and hallways each morning to greet students, help them find their way, and provide assistance whenever needed. Our teachers will then be ready to welcome students at their classroom doors and help them prepare for the school day.

This change is being made with our students at the center. A consistent arrival routine gives students an opportunity to develop independence, confidence, and responsibility, while allowing our teachers to focus their attention on welcoming students and beginning the school day in a calm and purposeful manner. Our arrival procedures are designed around our goal that “Students feel a greater sense of belonging while at SSCM,” with teachers personally welcoming students as they enter their classrooms.

We also believe this routine will benefit our entire school community. Students will experience a consistent transition from home to school, parents will have a clear and efficient morning routine, and faculty will be able to give their full attention to the students arriving in their classrooms.

We understand that new routines can take a little time to become familiar. During these first days, our staff will be especially attentive to students who may need additional reassurance or assistance. Our goal is not simply to get students from the front door to their classrooms—it is to make sure every child feels known, welcomed, supported, and ready for the day ahead.

Thank you for your partnership and for trusting us with your children each morning. We appreciate your support as we make this positive change for our students, families, and faculty. I look forward to greeting our students as they arrive and watching them grow in confidence throughout the school year.
