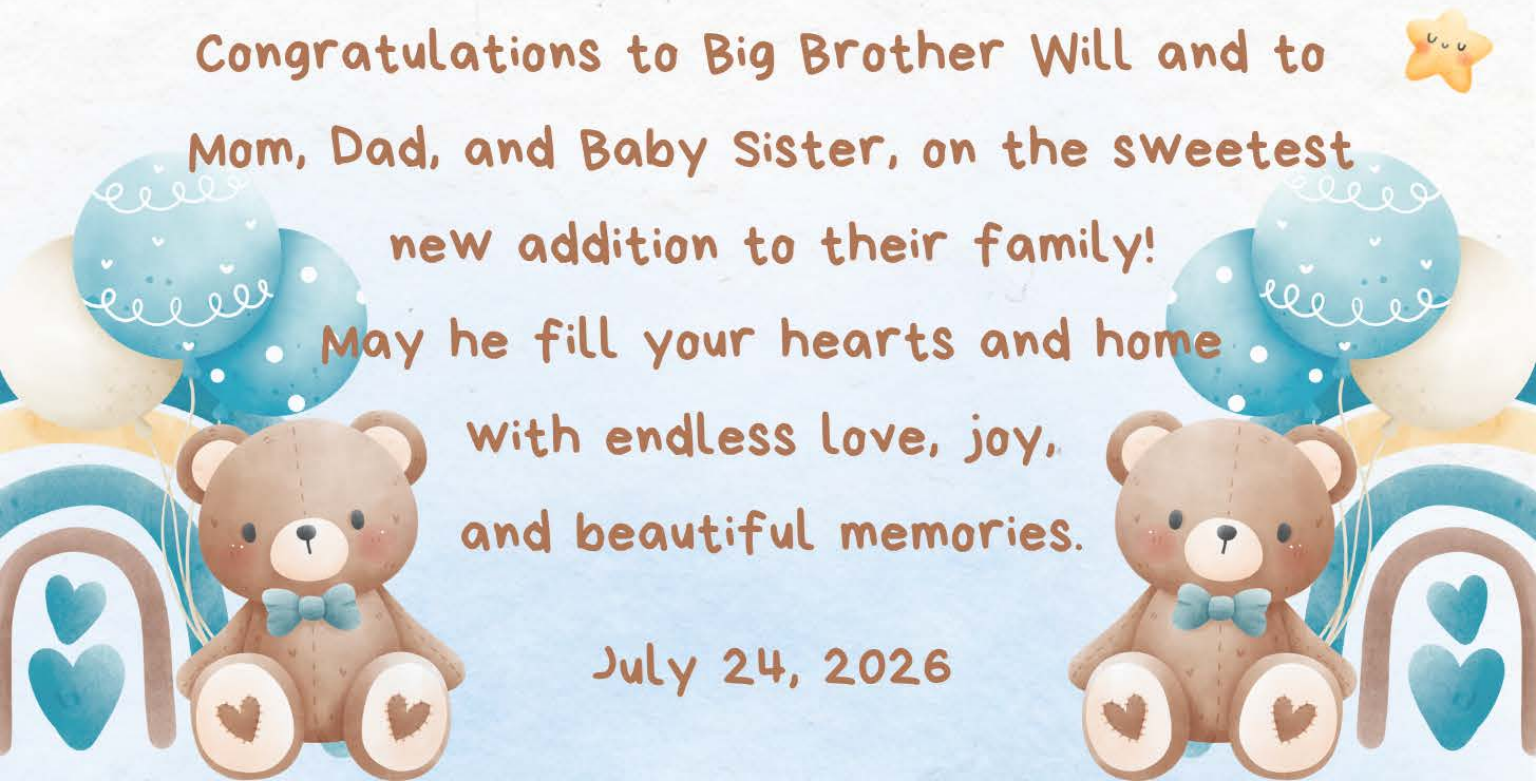

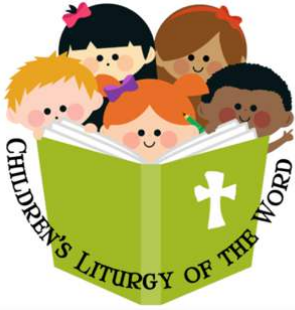

Returning to St. Cyril & Methodius September 13th at 9:30 Mass!



“The Children’s Liturgy of the Word”

When? Every Sunday during 9:30 AM Mass, September 13th through May 30th except Easter and Mother’s Day.

Why? A wonderful way to help children grades K-4 better learn and live the Sunday readings.

How does it work?

1. **GATHER:** Families with participating children please sit in the **front half of church** during 9:30 Sunday morning Mass, preferably **near the middle aisle**.
2. **LEAD:** As soon as opening Mass prayer is complete, and before the readings, the Adult Leaders and teen helpers will approach the altar in the center front of church carrying the book of Gospels.
3. **LINE UP:** Children in grades K-4 quietly and quickly line up behind the leaders with their hands folded. The teen helpers will assist and guide them into the line.
4. **BLESSING:** The priest celebrating Mass will bless the group, and then the children will devoutly move from the front of the church to the PLB meeting room.
5. **LEARN:** During this special 10–15-minute session, the Adult Leaders guide the children through simplified prayers, songs and the scripture readings of the day. They will do an activity to reinforce the lesson, then recite the Creed and their own Prayers of the Faithful.
6. **RETURN:** During the Offertory, the children will quietly process back into the church and return to their parents in the pews.

*Thank you to all the adult and teen volunteers
who make this opportunity available to our children each week.
Thank you to the parents who have so beautifully trained their children to be good!*
